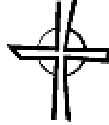

Intinction (dipping the bread into the chalice) is **no longer an acceptable practice** in this diocese. It is a significant health hazard. Anglican tradition allows for receiving communion in one kind only (just the bread). You should feel free to decline the chalice in circumstances such as flu outbreak. If, as well, you feel uncomfortable with our customary manner of exchanging the peace, you may gently bow instead of shaking hands.
