The Stewardship Development Department at the Diocese is working diligently to ensure that all gifts made in 2011 are accurately recorded in our database. Ordinarily, it takes approximately 3 weeks from the date the Diocese receives payment for cheques to clear the donor's bank account. However, due to the volume of year-end donations, we are still processing donations made prior to Dec 31, 2011. We expect that all gifts will be entered in our system by January 20 and the cheques deposited by the 27th.

Receipts will be mailed out in mid-February. In the interim, anyone who has made a gift or pledge to Our Faith Our Hope will receive a year-end statement that lists the amount of the gift or pledge, payments made toward a pledge, and balance remaining on the pledge. Please note that this is a statement only and that the official tax receipt will follow.
